Class 4. **I LOVE LUCY** - A romantic table for two staged on a 36” diameter x 29” H table, skirted in white. Exhibitor must provide overlay.

Class 5. **LEAVE IT TO BEAVER** - An Exhibition Table, Type II, staged using a black frame 40” W x 30” H on a white skirted table 4’ long x 30” W x 29” H. Exhibitor must provide overlay.

Class 6. **WAGON TRAIN** - An Alfresco buffet table for 6. Staged on a wood plank table 28” H x 60” L x 24” W. Exhibitor must provide table cover.

Eligible for Award of Distinction

Class 7. **HIGH NOON** - A Floor Design staged on sand within a square floor space 42” x 42”. To be viewed from the front.

Class 8. **AROUND THE WORLD IN 80 DAYS** - A Hanging Design Type II, using a 5’ H x 28” W x 4 ½” D black frame on a 12” H x 36” square black base.

Class 9. **AN AMERICAN IN PARIS** - A Design staged with a rosewood finished, 3 panel, 5’ 8” H x 54” W folding room divider. A 24” square x 36” H pedestal will be available to use.

Eligible for Petite Award

All designs in the section must be small-not to exceed 8” in any direction. Designer’s Choice of plant material in all classes. Each Small Design Class will have its own cream-colored box raised 48” from the floor. Each box

has four individually lighted 14" W x 11" D x 12" H niches. Designer must provide background and underlay to complement her/his design.
